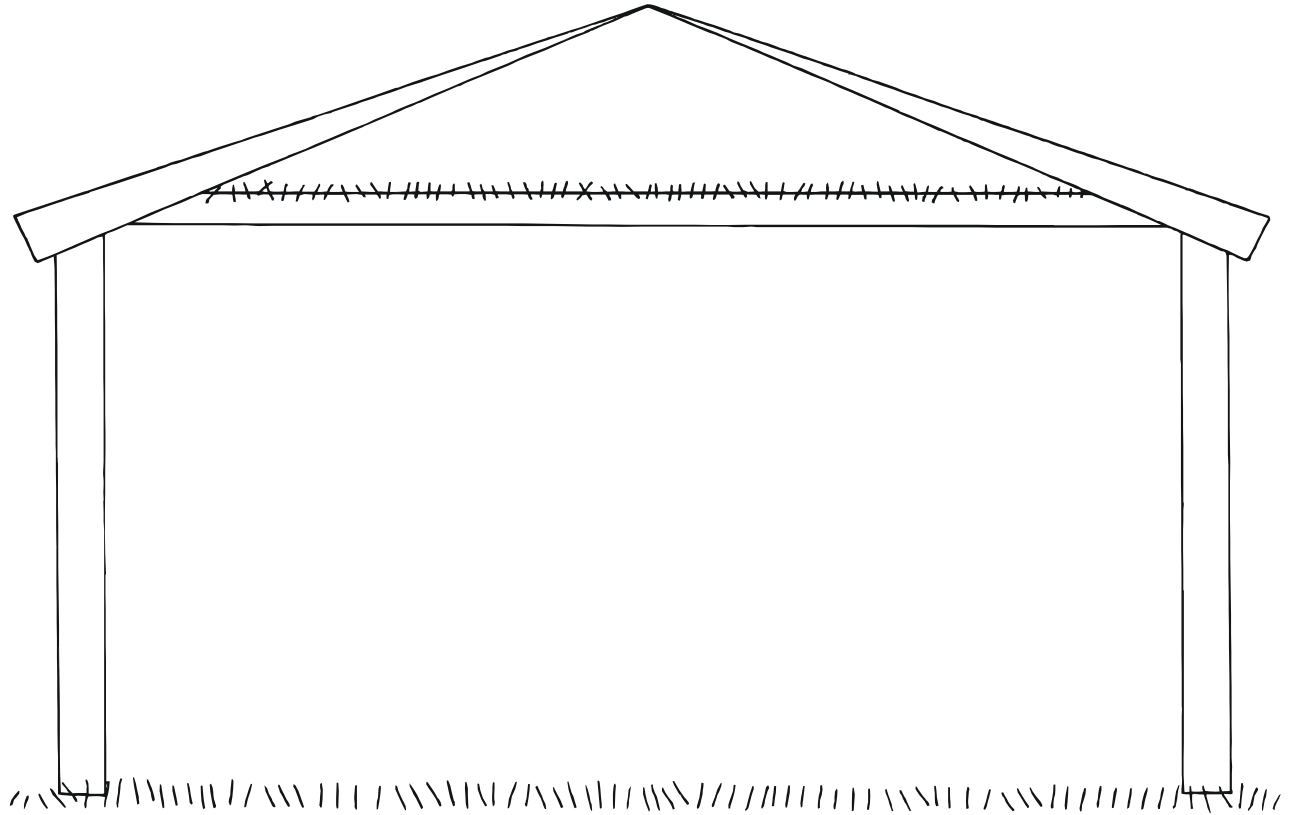


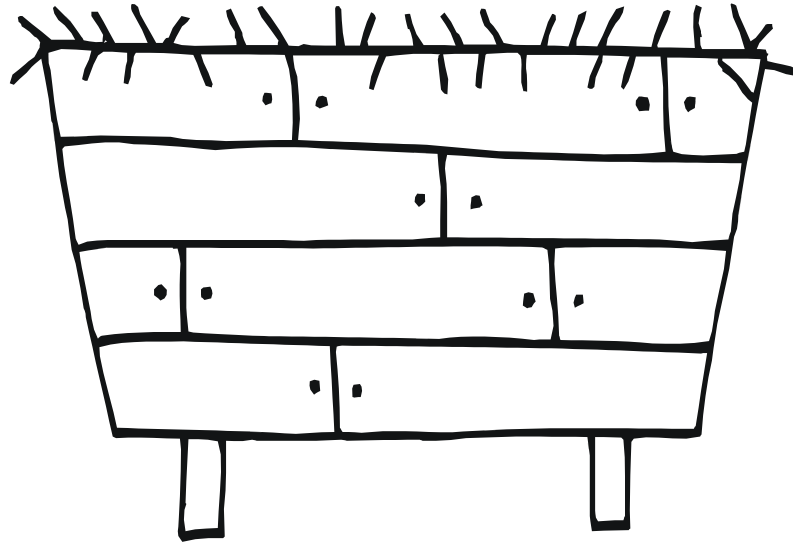
This is the new star

first Christmas night.



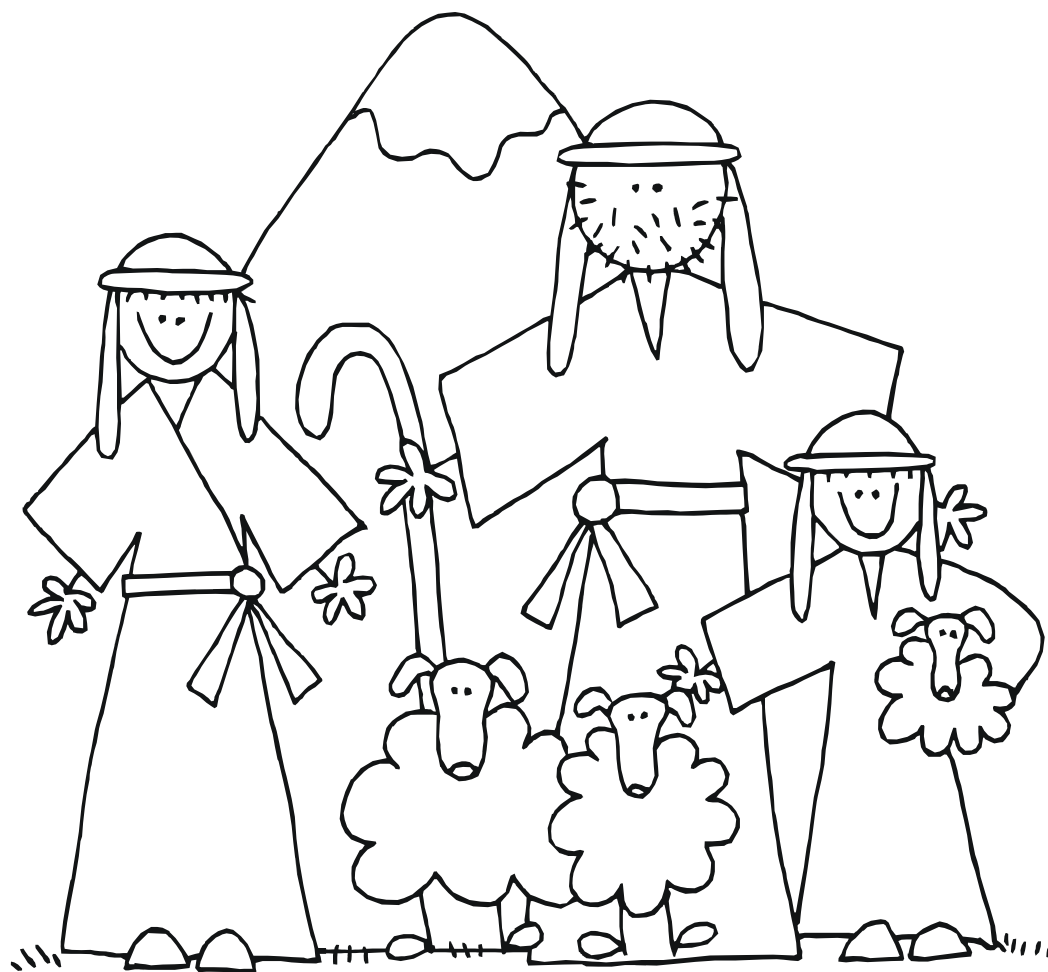
This is the angel

welcomed Christ there.



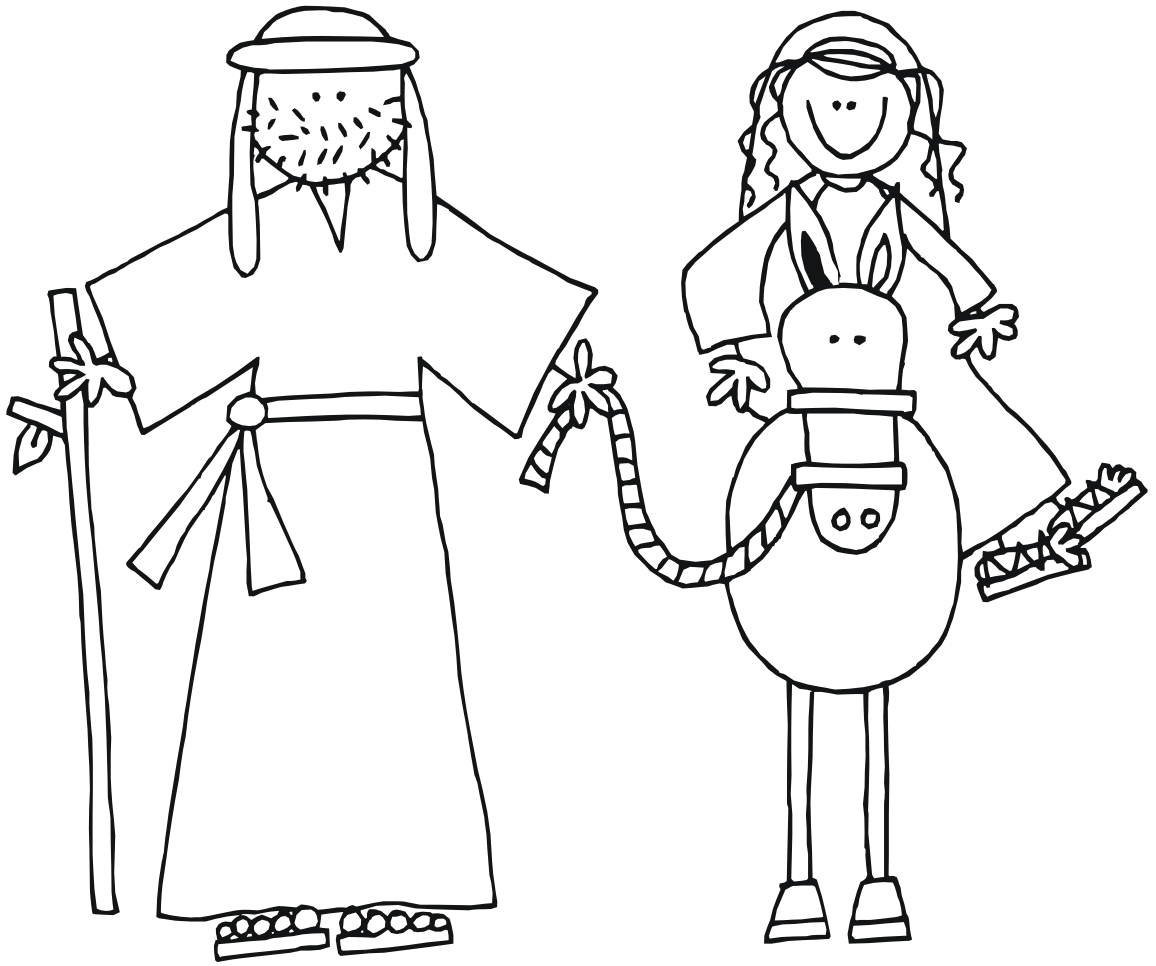
This is the manger—

cradle His head.



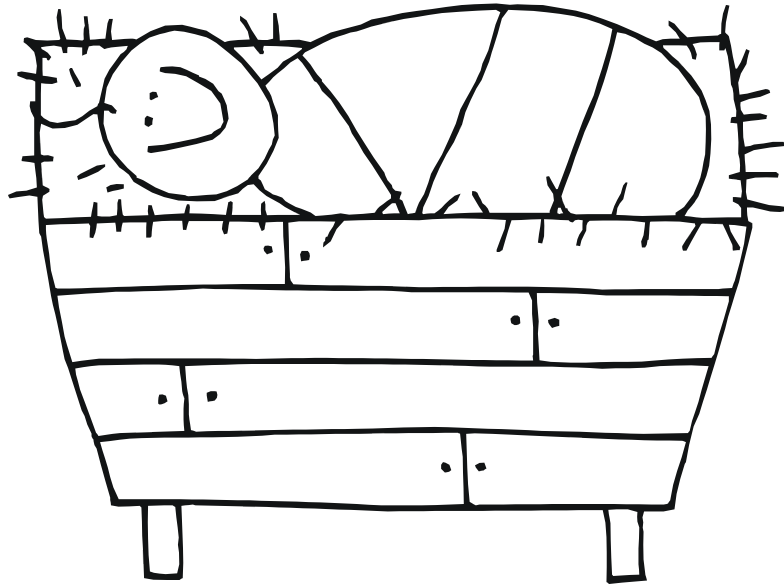
These are the shepherds,

donkey with care.



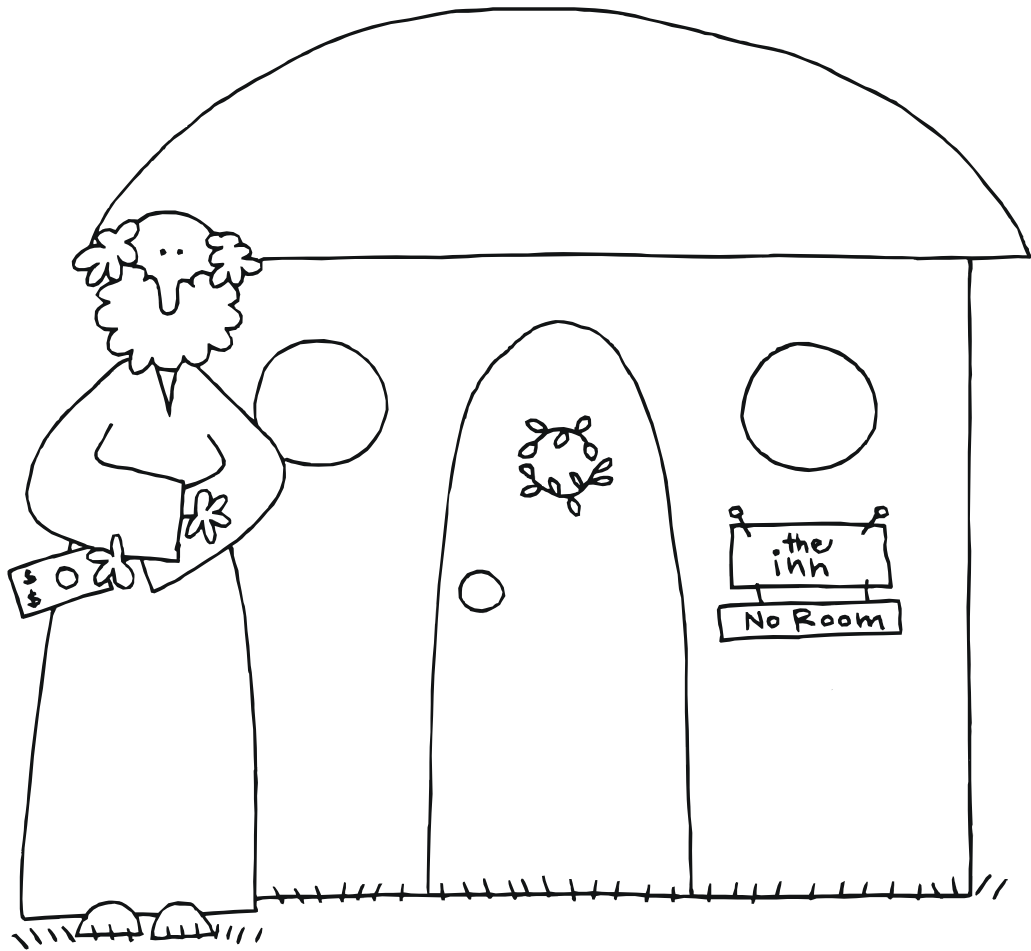
See the dear Baby of
